

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE, DETECT SMOKE OR HEAR A FIRE ALARM:

- 1. Leave the fire area immediately. Close windows and doors to the affected area as you leave.
- 2. Alert building occupants. Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station.
- 3. Evacuate the building using the nearest exit.
 - check all doors for heat before opening and if hot, find alternate path to exit.
 - If it is unsafe to evacuate, return to a safe area and call 911 to alert them to your location.
 - DO NOT use elevators.
- 4. Quickly move away from the building to your emergency gathering location. LOCATION: the east field past the academic building or inside the academic building in inclement weather.
- **5.** If you know the location or source of the fire or have information regarding any person in immediate danger that can not safely evacuate, call Security at 2009 or **705-345-1112** or call **911**.
- Do not re-enter the building until instructed to do so by Residence staff,Security or the Fire Department.

FIRE SAFETY INFORMATION:

- 1. Smoking is a major cause of fire deaths. This is a NON-SMOKING facility.
- 2. Tampering with fire equipment (smoke/heat detectors, extinguishers, fire hoses, sprinkler heads, this notice, etc.) is a serious offence and will be dealt with severely.
- **3.** Failure to leave the building during a fire alarm presents a danger to both yourself and others. It is illegal and in contravention of residence regulations.
- **4.** Hazardous substances may not be stored in your room. Examples would be gasoline, propane tanks/cylinders, chemicals, etc.
